



Requirements and Schedule for ICP Cohort 5

Requirements

The following summary of requirements involved in the Ignatian Colleagues Program (ICP) is provided as the basis of a more detailed conversation between the campus coordinator and potential participants and/or the program director. Specific dates for cohort 5 can be found in the schedule on the following page.

Involvement in the ICP generally involves participation in:

1. A four-day Orientation Experience outside of Chicago at the end of July.
2. A series of 6 online workshops, three of which are self-paced and three of which occur at the rate of one per semester. All workshops involve approximately ten hours of work and include reading articles, watching videos, participating in teleconference or in-person discussions, and writing a reflection paper.
3. A series of monthly meetings with the campus coordinator.
4. A weeklong international immersion experience to a developing country with peers (offered by the ICP or one's own campus.*
5. An approved experience of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius.
6. A one-day cohort gathering in Chicago approximately one-year into the process.
7. A "mission-project" that involves the application of program material to a project directly related to one's work.
8. A four-day Capstone Experience at the end of the program at the beginning of January.

*If one has participated in a qualifying international immersion experience or a significant experience of The Spiritual Exercises, she or he is not required to repeat the experience but will be invited to deepen it and integrate it into the program experience through further reflection.

Note: The texts we are using for the program are two books edited by George Traub, SJ and published by Loyola Press: *An Ignatian Spirituality Reader* and *A Jesuit Education Reader*.
